



## **TRALI Mitigation Protocol**

To reduce the incidence of TRALI, United Blood Services does not collect plateletspheres from multiparous females who have tested positive for HLA antibodies under the blood center's plateletpheresis donor HLA testing protocol. The blood center does not prepare frozen plasma for transfusion from females who have been pregnant, with one exception: the blood center may prepare frozen plasma for transfusion from blood type AB females who have been pregnant only if they test negative for HLA antibodies.

This is in compliance with:

- College of American Pathologists (CAP) TRM.42110 TRALI
  - The laboratory has developed a plan to reduce the risk of transfusion related acute lung injury.
  - Evidence of compliance - Written policy for measures to reduce the risk of TRALI OR records of communication with blood supplier on steps being taken to reduce the risk of TRALI.
